

**TOWN OF BOW MAR, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 326**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BOW MAR
AMENDING SECTIONS 4-15, 4-16, AND 4-17 OF THE BOW MAR MUNICIPAL CODE
CONCERNING THE PROCESS FOR ANNUAL TAX LEVY CERTIFICATION AND
APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Town of Bow Mar desires to amend Sections 4-15, 4-16, and 4-17 as provided in this ordinance to create additional efficiency in annual tax levy certification and appropriation of funds by permitting certification and appropriation by resolution, as permitted by C.R.S. § 29-1-108.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BOW MAR, COLORADO:

Section 1. Amendments to Sections 4-15, 4-16, and 4-17. Sections 4-15, 4-16, and 4-17 of the Bow Mar Municipal Code are hereby amended to read in full as follows, with additions shown in underline and deletions shown in strikethrough:

Sec. 4-15. – Certification of tax levy.

The Board of Trustees may levy taxes and fees as may be necessary to obtain revenue for the operation of the Town, to balance the budget, and for such other purposes as may be authorized by law. Not later than December 10, the Board of Trustees shall also adopt a tax levy ~~ordinance~~ resolution. Such ~~ordinance~~ resolution shall establish a tax levy, in mills, upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of taxable property within the corporate limits of the Town, and shall certify the same to the Board of County Commissioners for Jefferson and Arapahoe Counties and elsewhere as required by law no later than December 15, or such other date as may be set by law.

Sec. 4-16. – Appropriation.

Not later than December 31, the Board of Trustees shall adopt an appropriation ~~ordinance~~ resolution authorizing and appropriating expenditures for the coming year within the limits set in the budget. Such appropriations shall be detailed separately by fund. All appropriations resolutions must be approved by a majority of all Trustees.

Sec. 4-17. – Supplemental appropriations.

Appropriations in addition to those contained in the budget and the initial appropriation ~~ordinance~~ resolution may be made by resolution from time to time to meet a public emergency or unanticipated need.

Section 2. Safety Clause. The Board of Trustees hereby finds, determines, and declares that this ordinance is necessary and proper for the health, safety, and welfare of the Town and its residents.

Section 3. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including

each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more part, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase is declared invalid.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

Section 5. Codification Amendments. The codifier of the Town's Municipal Code, Municipal Code Corporation, is hereby authorized to make such numerical and formatting changes as may be necessary to incorporate the provisions of this Ordinance within the Bow Mar Municipal Code.
